General Information.

Administration: The offices of the staff are in the camp administration building.

Honorary Leaders: Honorary Leaders are friendly advisors to the various national groups. Any wishes or suggestions of the groups should first of all be mentioned to them and they will do everything in their power to satisfy them. The groups will receive their tickets for all events through them.

Meals: All meals will be taken together at the times specified in the programme. Special additional food is available at the stores at the members' own expense.

The Post office is in the Main Building across the street. Office hours for any kind of business from 8 a. m. to 4 p. m. Olympic stamps can be bought there in small quantities. Mail will be delivered through the camp administration three times a day immediately after arrival. Letter box at the post office. Collection 4 times a day. All letters will bear a special camp stamp.

Bank: The Bank is in the Main Building. Exchange of foreign currency in all amounts. Office hours from 10 a. m. to 3 p. m.

Telephone: The camp number is: J 3 7654 and J 3 7655. The members of the camp will be notified if there is a call for them. For local calls there are coin boxes in the post office, in the stores and in the refreshments hut. Long distance calls can be made only from the post office.

Lost Property: The lost property office for everything found in camp is in the Main Building. Everyone is asked to take every article found in camp to this office.

Traffic communications: Refer to special map on page 7.

Sleeping, Dining and Washing Tents: Refer to camp plan. The sleeping tents have to be kept tidy and clean by their occupants. Visitors are not admitted to them.

Refreshment Hut: Next to the camp entrance is a special refreshment hut for members and visitors. It is advisable to make all appointments between members and their visiting friends at this refreshment hut.

Visitors: Members of the Congress are admitted to the camp site, the sleeping tents excepted. Other guests and visitors are only permitted in the space specifically provided for them.

Showers: Shower baths are in the Main Building on the other side of the road.

Serving of meals: The serving of meals is to be done by 30 student volunteers from the student body of the University of Berlin.

Laundry, Pressing, Mending, and Cleaning of clothes: The laundry has been taken over by the „Studentenwerk“ of the Technische Hochschule (Technical College) Charlottenburg. The office is in the Main Building, open daily.

Entertainments: There will be music transmitted by loudspeakers every day, and concerts given by different military bands.

Motor Service, Transportation: There are 10 trucks for transportation available for official use. The distribution will be done by the camp administration. The parking ground is next to the Main Building.

Churches and Services: The notice or bulletin board will give particulars about services held in churches nearest to the camp. Refer also to the section „Besondere kirchliche Veranstaltungen“ (Special services) in the official Olympic Guidebook, page 156.

Television: A tent has been equipped with a television receiver by the district Berlin of the N.S.D.A.P. (national-socialist-workers-party). Admission to this tent which is in front of the sleeping tents is free of charge.

Notices: Notices from the camp leader will be put on the notice boards in camp every day and also given to the group leaders by their honorary leaders.

Doctor and medical service: Oberarzt Dr. Petri.
For medical advice and treatment of casualties refer to camp plan. Hours: any time.

Stores: In the store tents there are various stands. Books, stationary, sportswear, photoarticles, locks, hangers, clips, brushes, shoe polish, souvenirs etc. are for sale.

Newspapers: The most important daily newspapers of nearly all nations taking part in the camp can be bought at the news stand in the stores.

Hairdresser: A barber shop is in the Main Building. Toilet articles are also available.

Training facilities in camp: Athletics: The athletic fields with cinder tracks, adjoining the camp, are provided for the practice of all teams. All athletic events and exhibitions will take place there. The necessary athletic equipment, such as: shot, javelin, bars, stands etc., can be had only by permission of the „Sportleiter“ (sport leader). The equipment room is in the Main Building.

Swimming: The camp swimming pool is in Halensee, 5 minutes from the camp.

Tennis: There are 8 courts behind the Main Building for the use of camp members.

Boxing: Equipment only by special permission from the „Sportleiter“.

Shooting: The small calibre rifle range is immediately next to the camp entrance. Outfit and rifles by permission of the „Sportleiter“.

Silence: Silence 11 p. m. every day.
